Approach

- 5. To operate tills, take cash and give change in line with set procedures.
- 6. To act as an information point for quests about our bar promotions and events in the SU Bar.

- 9. To assist in the maintenance of bar displays and merchandising as required.
- 10. To keep the bar and public areas clean and tidy before, during and after opening hours and to undertake cleaning duties as required.
- 11. To dispose of rubbish in the correct manner in line with our recycling objectives.

Training and support: All bar staff will be given introductory training explaining the role and responsibilities and covering the basic skills required to undertake the role. Ongoing in-depth support is available throughout the year from the Bar Managers and Sabbatical Officers.
